

Biome Children's Book

Children's Book must:

Include the name of the biome.

Identify the location of biome (specific country) both with words and on a map. The map must show the location of the biome in relation to the equator.

Give a written description of seasons within the biome, including average temperature and average precipitation of each season. Must include pictures.

Identify common landforms found in the biome with pictures.

Identify and describe 3 producers living in biome (include niche descriptions and special adaptations). Must include pictures.

Identify and describe 3 primary consumers living in biomes (include niche descriptions and special adaptations). Must include pictures.

Identify and describe 3 secondary and/or tertiary consumers living in biomes (include niche descriptions and special adaptations). Must include pictures.

Identify environmental threats to the biome.

Describe ways people are trying to eliminate threats to the biome.

Be a minimum of 10 pages in length including front cover.

Turn in along with book:

A typed bibliography containing at least 5 reliable sources in MLA format (use easybib.com).

Biome Diorama and Paper

Paper must:

Include the name of the Biome. Biome name should also be on the **diorama**

Identify the location of biome (specific country) and describe the location of the biome in relation to the equator.

Give a written description of seasons within the biome, including average temperature and average precipitation of each season.

Identify common landforms found in the biome. Include in **diorama**.

Identify and describe 3 producers living in biome (include niche descriptions and special adaptations). Include in **diorama**.

Identify and describe 3 primary consumers living in biomes (include niche descriptions and special adaptations). Include in **diorama**.

Identify and describe 3 secondary and/or tertiary consumers living in biomes (include niche descriptions and special adaptations). Include in **diorama**

Identify environmental threats to the biome.

Describe ways people are trying to eliminate threats to the biome.

Be a minimum of 2+ pages in length. Typed in 12 point Times New Roman font with standard margins and double spaced.

Turn in along with paper:

A typed bibliography containing at least 5 reliable sources in MLA format (use easybib.com).

*The bibliography page does not count as one of the 2+ pages of your paper.

Diorama:

Must depict a 3-D scene typical of the biome including common landforms.

Must include the biome name.

Must include at least

3 producers

3 primary consumers

3 secondary or tertiary consumers
